Equipment will be provided, and participants will take home the avvik they have made.

A member of the community will teach participants how to make slippers with duffle. Participants will take home the slippers they have made.

Material will be provided, and participants will take home the jigger they have made.

A member of the community will teach participants how to butcher a seal explaining all the organs/body parts and what they were traditionally used for.

This session will teach participants how to clean and prepare a seal skin for drying.

Instructors will facilitate this session by teaching participants about local plants in our park by identifying, explaining how they were used before modern techniques and how they are used today.

Equipment will be provided, and participants will take home the ulu they have made.

A member of the community will facilitate this session to teach participants how to create their own prints.
